Application - Limitations of use

Hand protection

Do not use against flames or temperatures < - 25°C or > 100°C

Do not use for heavy duty mechanical applications

Do not use against chemicals; the glove is not liquidproof

Storage

Keep away from sources of ozone or ignition.

Keep out of direct sunlight; store in a cool and dry place.
